



## Making a Gift in Will

**We are pleased to provide the following wording that may be used by your Solicitor to enable bequests to the orchestra.**

### 1. Cash Gift

The clause is appropriate when the gift is a sum of money, which is an absolute gift and does not have any limitations (ie the gift is not for a term such as a life interest or for a specific purpose).

Clause

(i) I give to Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd ABN 094 916 444 the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ (please specify) for its general purposes;

(ii) The receipt of the Chief Executive Officer for the time being of Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd is an absolute discharge to my executor.

### 2. Specific Gift of Property

This clause is for those instances where the gift consists of specific property such as land, artwork etc. This clause is drafted to enable the executors of the will to convert specific gifts into money upon the written request of the Chief Executive Officer.

Clause

(i) I give to Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd ABN 094 916 444 absolutely and free of all duties and encumbrances my (describe specific property).

(ii) The receipt of the Chief Executive Officer for the time being of Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd is an absolute discharge to my executor.

(iii) At the written request of the Chief Executive Officer of Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd, my executor(s) may sell or otherwise convert into money the subject matter of this gift and dispose of it in accordance with sub-paragraphs (i) and (ii).

### 3. Gift of Residuary Estate

This clause is for those instances where, perhaps after specific gifts of the estate have been given, there are still items of property remaining that have not been gifted to anyone. This clause is drafted to enable people to leave the remainder of their estate (called the residuary estate) to Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd.

Clause

(i) I give the residue of my estate to Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd ABN 094 916 444 absolutely and free of all duties and encumbrances;

(ii) The receipt of the Chief Executive Officer for the time being of Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd is an absolute discharge to my executor.

(iii) At the written request of the Chief Executive Officer of Queensland Symphony Orchestra Pty Ltd, my executor(s) may sell or otherwise convert into money all or any parts of the subject matter of this gift and dispose of it in accordance with sub-paragraphs (i) and (ii).
